The Social Science Department and the Associated Students of Pasadena City College (ASPCC) are hosting a Town Hall with Assemblyman Mike Gatto. Assemblyman Gatto, representing the 43rd State Assembly District, will speak on the plans and policies he seeks to pursue this legislative session in Sacramento. Among other legislation introduced, the Assemblyman has most recently introduced legislation to study the possibility of building a new University of California campus dedicated to solely STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics) subjects – a “public Caltech.” The town hall will feature a direct Q&A format where students can

ask Assemblyman Gatto any questions regarding prevalent issues as he strives to represent his district in the State Capitol. Come for the unique opportunity to have direct access to an elected official working to represent local Californians.

We'll provide service hours for club members to attend, and also we'll need help around 4:30 PM that day to set up if anyone is interested. So that's about 3 hours and 30 minutes of volunteer hours for anybody interested and certain polis ci professors are offering extra credit.
